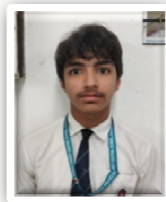


Aryabhata Ganit Challenge-2024

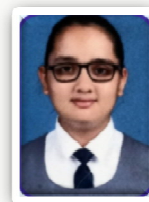
