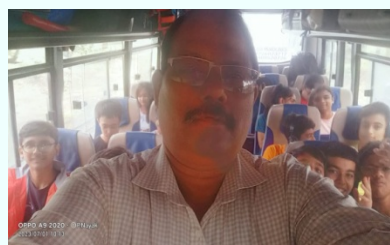






## NCC

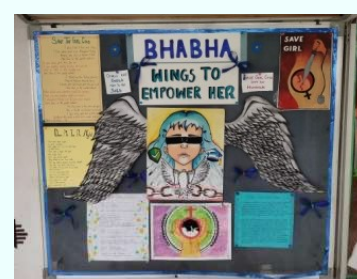

## CBSE Aryabhata Ganit Challenge-2023

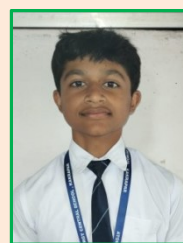

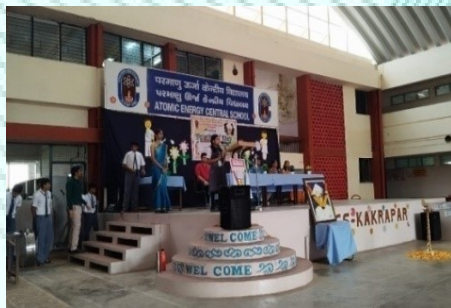
## Teachers' Day Celebration-2023

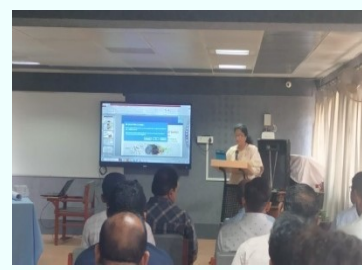






## CBSE Trainings for the teachers

### Inter AECS Athletic Meet-2023

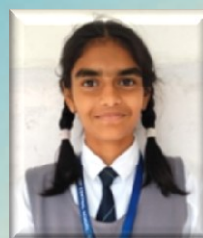

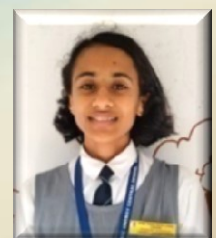

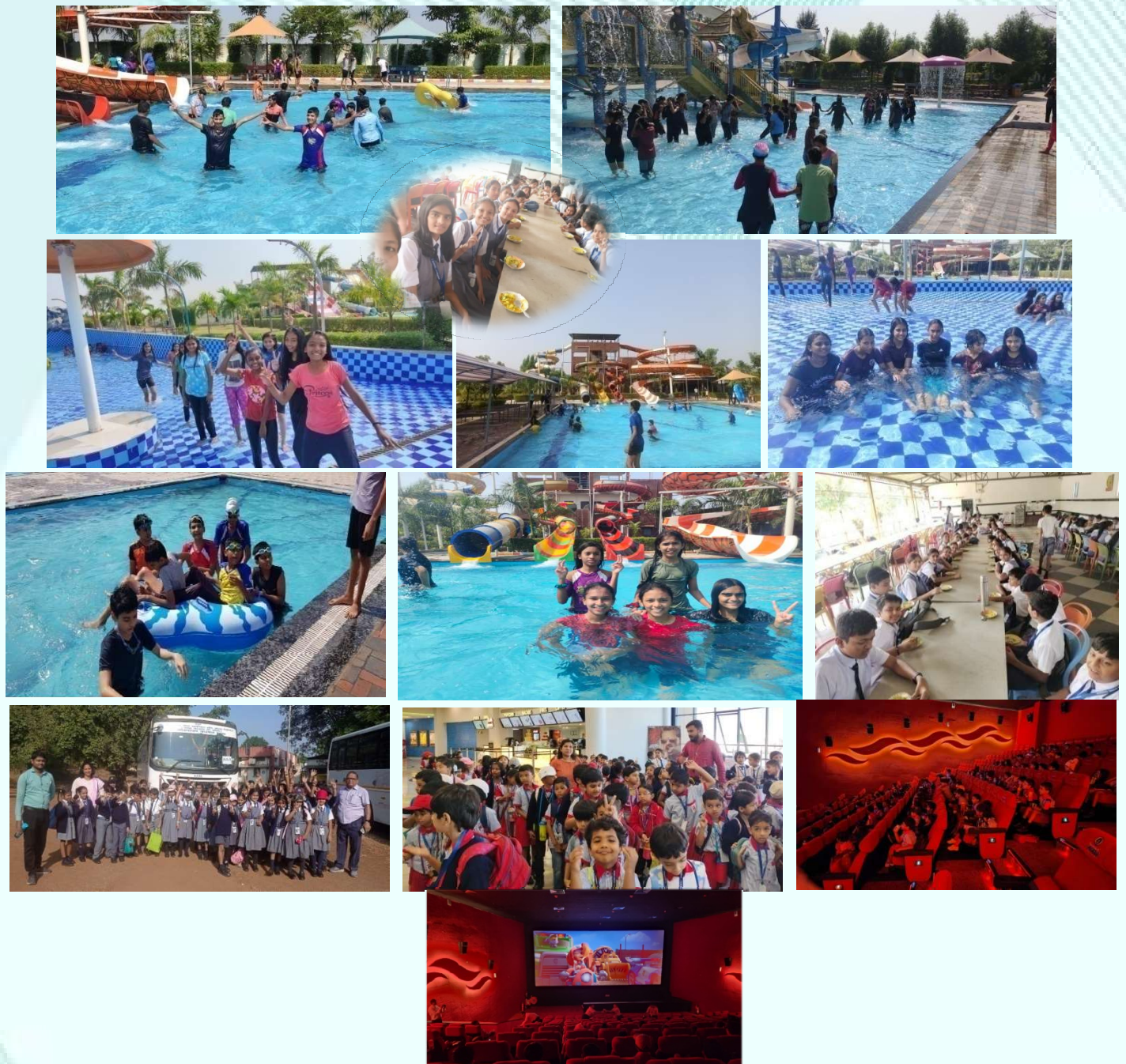


## School Excursion-2023
